Entering Grades 1–5

Adventure Day Camp is a combination of field trips, achievement based skill building activities and themed curriculum such as STEM, arts and crafts and physical activities designed to keep your campers engaged and stimulated.

Children should be at site from 9 AM to 4 PM daily in order to participate in all of the activities. Departure and arrival times occasionally change for specific trips and activities, so we encourage families to check the daily itinerary.

Children must be at least six years of age to be in the pool on swimming field trips in Oregon. Participants under six will be provided with an alternate activity.

General Information

Registration

- **The deadline for Early Bird registration is May 17, 2019. Camp reservations are on a first come, first serve basis.**
- Online registration is available beginning Apr. 22 at ymcacw.io/summer-camps2019. When registering online, health forms must be submitted to our office two weeks prior to starting camp.
- There is a \$35 deposit per child, per week, to secure a spot at the location of your choice. Deposits are applied to the corresponding weekly fee and are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- We will send confirmation of registration via email or mail.
- All programs are closed on July 4. All programs will also be closed on either Aug. 23 or Aug. 30. Please see desired site for details.
- If using paper registration, please mail or drop off the registration form, deposits and registration fee at our office 9500 SW Barbur Blvd. Ste 240, Portland, OR 97219. Faxed registration forms are not accepted. Please allow three business days for processing.
- The registration fee is a one time fee for our 2019 Summer Day Camp and is due upon receipt of paper registration. One child is \$30 and two or more children are \$50. Registration fee is waived for online registrations and Level 1 registered families.
- All registrations need to go through an approval process and are dependent upon space availability.
- Cancellation of camp weeks must be done in writing a minimum of two weeks prior to the camp start date to avoid the full week charge.
- Spaces will be limited to year-round families for weeks 9-11 held at SE Y Arts, Earl Boyles and Portland Arthur Academy locations. On July 22, weeks 9-11 in Portland will be open to the general public.

What is the Payment Process?

- Accounts must be current to register for camp.
- The balance for each camp week (camp rate, minus deposit) is due 14 days prior to the first day of camp. A late fee of \$15 will be applied to each week per child, if payment is not received on time. Children may not attend camp until the week is paid.
- Registrations received less than 14 days prior to the start of camp require payment in full.
- We accept third party billing. Please contact us at 503.946.5005 for details.
- When you register online you are automatically charged weekly fees on the due date with the card on file.

Are Part-time Options Available?

All camps, unless noted, operate five days per week (M-F). Part-time may be available after May 17 for a \$65 per day fee. Contact our office for more information. Please note that for part-time participation, days of attendance must be established before camp begins. Various activities, including field trips, differ at each location. Please note, when choosing the part-time option, your child will miss some activities. **Online registration is not available for part-time participants.**

Are There Any Discounts?

- There is a 10 percent discount for multiple children in one household attending the same location. The discount applies to the child with the lesser rate.
- A \$25 discount for week three is applied, because we are closed on July 4. The discount is applied to either week 11 or 12 as a result of the Aug. 23 and/or Aug. 30 in-service closures.

What if I Can't Afford Camp?

- The YMCA provides financial assistance to low-income family households.
- Financial Assistance forms are available at our office or online at ymcacw.io/financial-assistance.
- We will evaluate the application and will notify you of the amount awarded via email or mail. Applications must be received and processed by our office two weeks prior to the first week of camp you wish to register for.
- Financial Assistance is not retroactive.

Accommodating Campers Needs

The YMCA complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act. We welcome, encourage and support the participation of all children in our YMCA Summer Day Camps. Our summer programs operate in large group settings that include activities such as group games, crafts, swimming and field trips.

You will need to contact us to request accommodations a minimum of 10 business days before the start of the program. Depending on your camper's needs we may have you meet with a Program Director and complete additional paperwork before your camper's start date to ensure that they can be successful in the day camps.

A lack of communication or a failure to provide information prior to the camp start date may jeopardize placement and/or continued participation.
