It is further warranted that such entry into the YMCA for observation or use of any facilities or equipment or participation in such affiliated program constitutes an acknowledgement that such premises and all facilities and equipment thereon and such affiliated program have been inspected and carefully considered and that the undersigned finds and accepts same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purpose of such observation, use of participation by the undersigned and such children.



Behavior Guidelines & Disciplines

The Sherwood YMCA Teen Center provides teens with a safe and fun environment where they can develop healthy relationships with both peers and staff. In order to ensure a positive experience for all who enter the Teen Center, we expect our teens to act respect-fully at all times when they are on YMCA property and/or participating in our activities. Teens are to behave in a mature, responsible way encompassing the YMCA core values of respect, responsibility, honesty, and care.

The Sherwood YMCA Teen Center encourages teens to have fun and engage in a wide variety of activities. However, there are certain rules that are non-negotiable:

Teens will respect the feelings of all Teen Center participants, staff, and community members.

Aggressive behavior such as physical violence of any kind, including verbal put downs, inappropriate language, bullying, and disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated.

Teens will follow directions given by Teen Center staff regarding safety, rules, and activities.

The Sherwood YMCA has authority to terminate and/or dismiss any person in the building whose behavior is noncompliant to YMCA guidelines.

The goal for the YMCA Teen Center discipline policy is to help build responsible teens who make good choices and take responsibility for their actions and behavior.

Level 1: Arguing, swearing, refusing to listen, being inappropriate, etc.

First Incident:

Staff member(s) will have a conversation with the teen as to why choices were made. The teen will be provided with a detailed explanation as to why the behavior was not acceptable. Redirection from activity or situation may be needed.

Second Incident:

Staff member(s) will have a conversation with the teen as to why choices were made. The teen will be provided with a detailed explanation as to why the behavior was not acceptable

Redirection from activity or situation may be needed.

Parents/guardians will be notified of the situation and informed with details and a future plan of action

Third Incident:

Staff member(s) will have a conversation with the teen as to why choices were made. The teen will be provided with a detailed explanation as to why the behavior was not acceptable

Redirection from activity or situation may be needed.

Parents/guardians will be notified of the situation and informed with details and a future plan of action

The teen will face possible termination from the Sherwood Teen Center

Level 2: Violence (i.e. hurting others, self, or property), harassment, stealing, or threatening staff, participants, or community.

First Incident:

Staff member(s) will have a conversation with the teen as to why choices were made. The teen will be provided with a detailed explanation as to why the behavior was not acceptable.

Parents/Guardians will be notified of the situation and informed with details and a future plan of action.

The teen will face possible termination from the Sherwood Teen Center.
